BLEACH

Bleach has been declared to be effective in the elimination of germs. A mixture of one part bleach and ten (10) parts water is the bleach mixture referred to:

Bleach will be used:

1. To clean and disinfect surfaces, utensils, clothing, linen, gloves, etc., exposed to body fluids.
2. On commodes, urinals, face bowls, changing tables, etc., after they have been cleaned with soap and water (spray on it).
3. On the walls in the bathrooms. Walls will be cleaned on a regular basis, but will be sprayed at least once daily with the bleach solution.
4. On the bathroom floors daily, after they have been mopped.
5. Mops should be rinsed with bleach after use.
6. As often, at any other time, or on any other articles, surfaces, etc., as deemed necessary by the staff, to help eliminate germs.

* Bleach and the Bleach Mixture will be kept out of reach of the children.

** Use a solution of 1/4 cup bleach to one gallon of water, one tablespoon to one quart, to disinfect toys, furniture, and other surfaces.
