## BLEACH

Bleach has been declared to be effective in the elimination of germs. A mixture of one part bleach and ten (10) parts water is the bleach mixture referred to:

Bleach will be used:

- 1. To clean and disinfect surfaces, utensils, clothing, linen, gloves, etc., exposed to body fluids.
- 2. On commodes, urinals, face bowls, changing tables, etc., after they have been cleaned with soap and water (spray on it).
- 3. On the walls in the bathrooms. Walls will be cleaned on a regular basis, but will be sprayed at least once daily with the bleach solution.
- 4. On the bathroom floors daily, after they have been mopped.
- 5. Mops should be rinsed with bleach after use.
- 6. As often, at any other time, or on any other articles, surfaces, etc., as deemed necessary by the staff, to help eliminate germs.

\* Bleach and the Bleach Mixture will be kept out of reach of the children.

\*\* Use a solution of 1/4 cup bleach to one gallon of water, one tablespoon to one quart, to disinfect toys, furniture, and other surfaces.
