CHILD SCREENINGS AND DISABILITY REFERRAL PROCESS

§ 45 CFR 1302.33

GOAL STATEMENT- MCAEOC will strive for excellence by enhancing educational services to support school readiness of children that will maximize their potential to enter kindergarten with a solid foundation for reading success.

POLICY: A program must complete or obtain a current developmental screening within 45 calendar days of when the child first attends the program.

PURPOSE: The developmental screening helps to identify possible problems that a child may have in development, behavior, motor skills, language, social, cognitive, and/or emotional skills. If warranted, through screening results or additional relevant information, referrals will be made to the appropriate agency (Part B/Part C) for further evaluations after parental consent has been obtained.

PROCEDURES:

- 1. When a child falls below the cutoff on a developmental screening, articulation screener (3-5-year-olds), or an ASQ-3 (birth -3) screening, the following steps will be completed:
 - a. The MCAEOC classroom teachers will fill out an agency referral form.
 - b. The parent/guardian will complete and sign a Referral Information Form for Birth-3 and a Crowley's Ridge Demographic Information Form for 3–5-year-old children.
 - c. MCAEOC teachers will send a copy of the Brigance Screen III (3-5-year-old), or a copy of the ASQ-3 (birth -3) to the Disability Manager.
 - d. MCAEOC teachers will send a copy of the Brigance Online Screen III Summary Sheets (2 pages).
 - e. MCAEOC teachers will send a copy of the Articulation Screener (3-5-year-old).
 - f. MCAEOC teachers will send a copy of the child's current vision and hearing screening.
 - g. The above information will be faxed or scanned to:
 - Disability Manager
 - Central Office Fax: 870-776-1875
 - h. A telephone call will be made to the Disability Manager to inform him/her of the faxed referral
- 2. The Disability Manager or Disability Monitoring Coordinator will send the referrals to the local agency responsible for implementing IDEA for a formal evaluation to assess the child's eligibility for services under the IDEA (Part B, 3-5-year-olds), or (Part C, birth-3)
- 3. Parental consent on agency referral and follow-up form is encouraged.
