RECRUITMENT OF CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

§ 45 CFR 1302.60

GOAL STATEMENT- MCAEOC will strive for excellence by enhancing educational services to support school readiness of children that will maximize their potential to enter kindergarten with a solid foundation for reading success.

POLICY:

The grantee must incorporate specific activities to actively locate and recruit children with disabilities ages six weeks to five years of age.

PURPOSE: To ensure that at least ten percent of the enrollment opportunities are made available to children with disabilities.

PROCEDURES:

- 1. Public announcements.
- **2.** Follow-up from the Community Needs Assessment.
- **3.** Receive referrals from other agencies such as Department of Human Services Health Departments, Crowley's Ridge Education Service Cooperative, First Connections, FOCUS, parents, pediatricians, and other private professionals.
- **4.** Child Find posters and flyers will be posted throughout the service areas.
- 5. All staff will receive training concerning federal legislation regarding non-discriminatory recruitment of children with disabilities and Head Start's commitment of providing accessible facilities for disabled children and their families.
- **6.** Recruitment materials state clearly that the program seeks and serves children with disabilities including children with severe disabilities.
